#### **4.: Further Clauses**

- All current competition regulations for fin swimming set by VDST apply to this competition as well as the additional clauses of the youth competition regulation.
- All athletes from the following counties are entitled to participate: Baden, Bavaria, Hessen, Rheinland-Pfalz, Saarland, Saxony, Thuringia and Württemberg. All clubs that do not belong to either of the above-mentioned counties or from clubs abroad are only entitled to participate in an open judgement.
- The sports medicine screening shall not date farther back than one year. All athletes without such screening are barred from the competition.
- All competition IDs must be handed in for control prior to competition start.
- The use of any swimsuits is permissible according to the regulations set by VDST 2016 (compliant to CMAS).
- **Contrary to the rule: You are to bring filled compressed air bottles.**
- All compressed air bottles that are to be used for competition must be TÜV-certified. It shall not exceed 200 bars. It is not permitted to enrich the respiratory gas with oxygen. It will not be possible to refill the air bottles in the swimming hall.

## **5.: Technical Control**

- Technical control is done prior to the start.
- Every athlete called to competition must remain with the entire equipment used to compete until he is allowed to start. Any breach results in dismissal of the respective competition.
- Every compressed air bottle used in the swimming hall must be certified to have been technically controlled currently, no older than 2,5 years back. This must be certified by TÜV or any other equivalent inspecting authority.

## **6. "One-start-rule"**

- The "one-start-rule" applies throughout the entire competition.

## **7.: Judgement**

- Athletes of the hosting state associations:

### *Single Judgement:*

- all age groups born in 2000 and younger are judged separately
- all age groups born in 1996 – 1999 are judged as juniors
- all age groups born in 1995 and older are judged as FEMALE / MALE

### *Relay Judgement.*

Category E	years 2006 / 2007
Category D	years 2004 / 2005
Category C	years 2002 / 2003
Category B	years 2000 / 2001
Juniors	years 1996 – 1999
Female/Male	years 1995 and older

- All athletes competing in open judgement are judged independent of year and club
- All athletes competing in open international judgement are judged independent of year, country and club.

The pricing ceremonies are only conducted for the specific age groups. First to third place will be honoured with certificates. All certificates for the 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place as well as 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place of juniors, adults and open judgement will be delivered after to their holders after the competition.

## **Trophy Judgement**

Cat. F: 2008 and younger:	4 routes with the highest points are added (single competition)
Cat. E: 2006/2007	4 routes with the highest points are added (single competition)
Cat. D: 2004/2005	5 routes with the highest points are added (single competition)
Cat. C: 2002/2003	6 routes with the highest points are added (single competition)
Cat. B: 2000/2001	6 routes with the highest points are added (single competition)
Cat. A: 1999 and older	6 routes with the highest points are added (single competition)

The German record is equalled to 1000 points. Every athlete receives judgment according to his or her performance under the terms of the 1000-point-chart. Only best performances are considered for judgment as per category. All points are added and the athlete having gained the highest amount of points will be rewarded a trophy. In case of point equity, the highest points in the single route will be taken into calculation. In case of a further point equity, the younger athlete will win. All female and male athletes are judged separately.

### **1. Competition Judges**

- It consists of the judges provided by the respective clubs. All clubs with only one competing athlete or guest from abroad do not have to provide a judge.
- Each club is to provide one judge to 19 single athletes; it must be 2 judges from 20 single athletes onward.
- The judges are to be called by name and license number when handing in their announcement. Only licensed judges are allowed.
- Every club being obliged to provide a judge must meet the correct amount of judges according to the above-mentioned allotment for the entire competition.
- There will be a fee for failing to provide the necessary number of judges. A fee of €50 per competition segment without a judge is to be paid.

### **2. Objections & Jury**

- Any objections must be handed in writing and no later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results (see the posting in the swimming hall). A charge of €30 must be deposited at the main referee's office. A jury is appointed at the team leader's meeting on the first day of the event.

### **3. Other fees**

- Basic amount per team: €15,00
- Per single athlete: €4,00
- Per relay: €7,00

- Note: when registering non-electronically, the charge increases by €1,00. (DSV6-, Lenex-file or via the online gantry)

## **6. Further Advice**

- Cooling down: the 25m pool is only available at certain times. The times and the specific lanes are announced during the team leader meetings.
- Locker deposit: A deposit of €5,00 is to be paid per locker at the entrance of the swimming hall.
- It is prohibited to stay in the stand (for spectators) in wet clothes. Any breach will result in disqualification.

## **7. Statement of Participation**

- All planned participation is to be communicated until 5<sup>th</sup> February 2017.
- The same applies to all provided judges to avoid an over- or understaffing. In case of an exceeding amount of judges, the host and the main judge will try to optimise the number.
