3. General Rules

- The competition regulations for finswimming of the VDST and the supplementary regulations of the youth competition regulations apply in their currently valid version and the supplementary regulations of the announcement. Teilnahmeberechtigt sind alle Vereine und deren Sportler/innen mit gültigem Startrecht für Finswimming-Wettbewerbe des VDST und Sportler ausländischer Vereine die in der CMAS registriert sind.
- The start is always from the block. The Masters are exempt from the obligation to snorkel.

• Fins for competition 5 and 6 50m FS - (crawl)

Only commercially available stereo fins may be used. It is forbidden to use monofins, fins with glass fibre blades, glass fibre reinforced parts as well as device fins with hard plastic reinforced fin blades or similar.

- Contrary to the rule, filled compressed air bottles must be brought along!
- It is possible to fill the DTG in the hall.
- If there is a lack of time, the breaks are omitted or shortened.

4. One-start rule

The "one-start rule" applies to the entire competition.

5. Competition court

The competition court is composed of the members of the arriving clubs. Each club has up to 20 entries, one and two judges. Clubs with only one starter are exempt from this requirement.

A cancellation fee of 55,00 Euro will be charged for the non-position of a judge on the day of the competition. Foreign clubs are exempt from this regulation.

The oldest relay participant is decisive for the allocation of the relays in the category year.

The evaluation of mixed relay teams takes place in the men's category in accordance with the age group regulations.

The years in the Masters relay classification result from the addition of the life years of the starters. Deadline for the age is 01.01.2019.

Places 1 to 6 will receive certificates. Only the award ceremonies for the age groups D, E and F will be held. The certificates for the other age groups will be issued at the end of the event.

7. Cup and prizes

Categories: I.: 2001 and older

II.: 2002 - 2005
III: 2006 and younger
IV: Masters AK I - III

The German record (for 200m ST the current event records) is set equal to 1000 points.

The competitions 105/106 and 201/202 do not go into the cup standings.

Each athlete receives the corresponding point value according to the 1000 point table for his performance. The two best performances will be included in the ranking. The points are added and the athlete with the most points in categories I. to IV. is awarded the trophy separately for female and male. In case of a tie, the higher point value of the best single distance counts. If there is still a tie, the younger athlete wins. The winners will receive a trophy and a bonus of 50,00 Euro. Places 1 to 6 will receive certificates.

8. Protests (complains)

Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the announcement of the competition results against a deposit of 30.00 euros.

10. Limit time for 1500m FS, increased late entry fee

An increased retrospective entry fee is charged if the swimmer does not compete, does not finish the competition, is disqualified or does not reach the required limit time. The ENM is 20,00 Euro. The payment of the ENM is not required if the required limit time was reached in a competition from 25.11.2018 to 14.11.2019 and can be proven with a protocol.
