3. General Regulations

The rules of the CMAS (2008/02) are valid. Every club and team, which is acknowledged by the VDST and whose athletes are in possession of a VDST computer number is eligible. Competitors from foreign countries have to be in possession of a CMAS accredited licence. Valid competition cards of the athletes must be handed over at the office until the deadline for application. The permission to take part has to be available until the closing date for applications and has to be proved by the competition card on the day of competition.

The session of the team leaders and referees takes place half an hour before the beginning of the competition. The physical check up must not be older than a year on the day of competition. Competitors without a valid physical check up will be barred from the competition.

The start is basically the starting block and the competition for the use of a snorkel FS 50 for respiration is mandatory. The Masters are exempt from the obligation to snorkel.

Note to the fins for competition 11 and 12 (50m Bi-Fins): It may only be used commercially Stereoflossen. Prohibited Monoflossen, fins with fiberglass blades, fins or similar units and Glass fiber reinforced with hard plastic fin blades.

It's possible to refill diving equipment on location (max. pressure of 200 bar). Only diving equipment with valid technical inspection is to be used. Please pay attention to the transport of dangerous material.

4. One-Start-Rule

There is only one single start, accordingly there is no false start or any regulation belonging to it, except the case of a dysfunction of the starting machine. Athletes who act or provoke before signal will be disqualified after the race.

5. Ranking

Single categories:

- age class A 1995 and older
- age class B 1996 / 1997
- age class C 1998 / 1999
- age class D 2000 / 2001
- age class E 2002 / 2003
- age class F 2004 and younger

Master categories:

- AK I 25–34 years
- AK II 35-44 years
- AK III 45-54 years
- AK IV 55-64 years
- AK V 65 years and older

It is to declare at the starting application, if the competitor starts in category age class A or AK25. This choice is obligatory for all starts of the competitor.

Relay categories:

- age class A 1995 and older
- age class B 1996 – 1999
- age class C 2000 and younger

Decisive for the assignment of the teams in category Squadron is the oldest participant.

Relay categories masters:

- AK A - 100-149 years
- AK B - 150-199 years
- AK C - 200 years and older

At the relay master categories the years are the result of the addition of the competitor's ages. Appointed date is the 1st of January 2013.

The places 1 to 6 receive documents. The documents starting from place 4 are given by with the protocol depending on the timetable.

6. Qualification for the Final Rounds

- The eight-fin swimmers best times of the years 1996 and older the Heats will qualify for the A finals.
- The eight best times fin swimmers born 1997 and younger the Heats will qualify for the B-finals.
- For cancellations for the Finals (within 20 minutes after the announcement of the finalists by the Speaker) each move up to 3 reserve after athletes.

The winner will receive a premium of 50,00 € ,the second 30,00 € and the third 20,00 €, the places 1 to 6 receive documents. The documents starting from place 4 are given by with the protocol depending on the timetable.

7. Cup ranking

Categories:

- Category I 1995 and older
- Category II 1996 – 1999
- Category II 2000 and younger

The German Record is equated with 1000 score points. Each athlete receives score points for his/her performance according to a 1000 score points scale. The **two** best results (except finals results) are valid for final ranking. The points will be added separatly for men and women in the categories I to III and the athlete with the highest score in each category receives the winner's cup. In case of level score, the higher score on the best single distance counts. If there is still level score the younger athlete wins. **Places 1 to 3 receive a cup and a present or cash rewards**, places 1 to 6 receive a certificate.

8. Protests

Protest must take place in written form within 30 minutes after announcement of the results on a deposit of 30,00 Euro.

9. Application

Applications have to be made on the sheets attached. Starting cards are not required. Please don´t forget the official number of the competition card.


